QATAR'S FOREIGN MINISTRY said the ceasefire between Israel and Hamas will go into effect at 0630 GMT on Sunday. Israel lists more than 700 Palestinian prisoners Israel's Justice Ministry has published a list of over 700 Palestinian prisoners who are to be released under the ceasefire deal pausing the war with Hamas militants in Gaza. The ministry said the Palestinian prisoners would be released no earlier than 4 pm local time on Sunday, the day the exchange is set to begin. The list includes members of the Hamas and Islamic Jihad

militant groups, some of whom are serving lifetime sentences and are convicted of serious offenses such as murder. The list did not appear to include Marwan Barghouti, the 64-year-old who is the highest-profile prisoner held by Israel and seen by many Palestinians as a prime candidate to become their president in the future. He was a leader in the West Bank during the second Palestinian uprising in the early 2000s. Hamas has demanded that Israel release him as part of any ceasefire agreement, a possibility Israeli officials have ruled out.

BAREILY DAYS AHEAD of Donald Trump taking over as US President amid growing concerns over imposition of tariffs or crackdown in immigration, S Jaishankar, Minister of External Affairs outlined the global challenges due to "the weaponisation of market instruments and financial institutions". At the same time, he underlined the link between economic growth and strategic "autonomy". He also framed the China challenge saying the India-China relationship is trying to disentangle itself from the complications arising from the post-2020 border situation.

Covid experiences, there is today in the world a much sharper awareness of the risks to the international economy of over-concentration, be it in manufacturing or in emerging technologies. The growing weaponisation of economic capabilities, including market shares, has become a major source of anxiety. The digital era has also brought forth its own set of challenges, focused on trust and transparency. Individuals and societies can no longer be agnostic about where their data resides and how and by whom it is harnessed." Jaishankar will attend the inauguration of the US President and will also meet his

counterpart, US Secretary of State nominee Marco Rubio on the sidelines, along with Quad foreign ministers. "The challenge for India is to undertake its rise in such unpredictable circumstances. To do that, it has to accelerate both its internal growth and modernization, as well as de-risk its external exposure. At home, that is best done through political stability, broad-based growth and inclusive growth and continuing reforms. It means more focus on manufacturing as well as food and health security, while building the deep strengths that would make us competitive. Strategic autonomy, after all, is acquiring greater economic connotations," he said.

India, US pact on cybercrime

THE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION has signed a pact with New Delhi that provides for boosting cooperation in combating cybercrime and related challenges such as terror financing and violent extremism. The agreement on cybercrime investigations, signed in Washington on Friday, allows the agencies concerned of the two countries to step up the level of cooperation with respect to cyber threat intelligence and digital forensics, according to an Indian readout. "Cybercrime has intricate linkages with the common security challenges faced by India and the US," the MEA said.

TikTok says it will have to 'go dark' unless Biden acts

TIKTOK SAID IT will have to "go dark" this weekend unless the outgoing Biden administration assures the company it won't enforce a shutdown of the popular app after the Supreme Court on Friday unanimously upheld the federal law banning the app unless it's sold by its China-based parent company.



The Supreme Court in its ruling held that the risk to national security posed by TikTok's ties to China overcomes concerns about limiting speech by the app or its 170 million users in the United States. The decision came against the backdrop of unusual political agitation by President-elect Donald Trump, who vowed that he could negotiate a solution, and the administration of President Joe Biden, which has signalled it won't enforce the law - which was passed with overwhelming bipartisan support - beginning Sunday, his final full day in office. "TikTok should remain available to Americans, but simply under American ownership or other ownership that addresses the national security concerns identified by

Congress in developing this law," White House press secretary Karine Jean-Pierre said in a statement, noting that actions to implement the law will fall to the new administration. TikTok released a statement late Friday saying "statements issued today by both the Biden White House and the Department of Justice have failed to provide the necessary clarity and assurance to the service providers that are integral to maintaining TikTok's availability to over 170 million Americans." "Unless the Biden Administration immediately provides a definitive statement to satisfy the most critical service providers assuring non-enforcement, unfortunately TikTok will be forced to go dark on January 19," the statement said.

Death minutes away as I fled Bangladesh: Hasina

Also recalls two previous attempts when she escaped

DEPOSED BANGLADESH PRIME Minister Sheikh Hasina has said she and her younger sister Sheikh Rehana escaped death by just 20-25 minutes on August 5 last year when her Awami League government was toppled in a student-led mass uprising. In a brief audio note released by her party on its Facebook page, Hasina expressed her gratitude to god for saving her life. She also recalled two previous attempts on her life she narrowly escaped and said she believed that god had saved her life as part of a divine design to get something greater done by her. "We escaped death by just 20-25 minutes. I feel surviving the killings on August 21, surviving the large bomb in Kotalipara, or surviving on August 5, 2024, there must be a will of Allah, the hand of Allah. Otherwise, I wouldn't have survived this time," she is heard saying in Bangla in the audio clip. In a trembling voice, the 77-

year-old leader accused her political opponents of conspiring to get her killed. Hasina has been living in India since August 5 last year when she fled Bangladesh following a massive student-led protest that toppled her Awami League's 16-year regime. "I am suffering, I am without my country, my home, everything has been burned," said Hasina. Hasina survived several attempts on her life including that of the August 21, 2004 grenade attack on a party rally where she was addressing as the opposition leader. At least 24 people were killed in the attack. In 2000, Hasina, then the PM of Bangladesh, was scheduled to speak at a rally in Kotalipara

Upazila, Gopalganj district, when police discovered a time bomb weighing 76 kg, just 50 feet from the stage. On August 5 last year, security forces gave her 45 minutes to evacuate her official Ganabhaban residence saying an angry mob was proceeding towards the government establishment and her life was in danger. Hasina was initially flown to a nearby military air base and later an air force plane carried her along with Rehana to India. Shortly after she left Ganabhaban, the mob vandalised the premier's residence and set on fire her father Sheikh Mujibur Rahman's house-turned-museum at 32 Dhanmondi named after him.
